RoHS Statement

The Directive on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment is known as RoHS Directive (2002/95/EC). It became RoHS 2 by amendment (2011/65/EU) and RoHS 3 by 2015/863/EU; commonly referred to as the **Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive (RoHS)**. The RoHS directive took effect on July 1st 2006, and is required to be enforced and become law in each member state. This directive restricts the use of ten hazardous materials in the manufacture of various types of electronic and electrical equipment.

The product Lubo Lubrication doesn't contain the RoHS restricted substances (Lead, Cadmium, Mercury, Hexavalent Chromium, PBB, PBDE, DEHP, BBP, DBP, DIBP).
